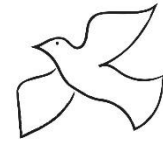

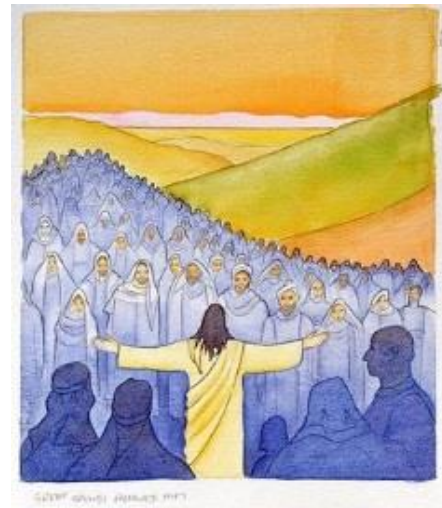

In pastures green; He leadeth me



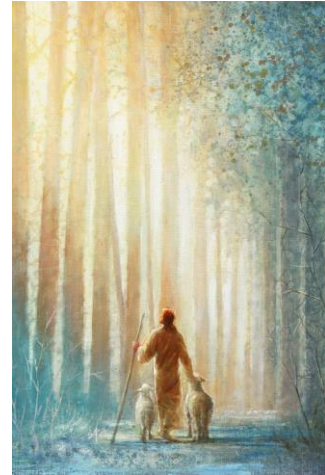
The quiet waters by.
